“EBI” SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR INTERNATIONAL YOUNG MONGOLISTS



The Embassy of Mongolia is now accepting applications for the “EBI” Scholarship Program for International Young Mongolists.

The National Council of Mongolian Studies, “Mongolian Foundation” NGO and “EBI” institute in Mongolia are organizing “EBI Scholarship Program for International Young Mongolists”. The program encourages and supports undergraduate students in a field of Mongolian Studies at the international universities, provides opportunities to learn the Mongolian language intensively and to become acquainted with the culture and lifestyles of the Mongolians.

The grant will cover the period between **07th and 18th August, 2017**. Scholarship recipients will visit to the Center for Mongolian Studies, and cultural and academic facilities in Ulaanbaatar, attend lectures delivered by renowned scholars and visit to the countryside to get acquainted with the customs and lifestyles of the Mongolians. The scholarship will provide applicants with round-trip flights to and from Mongolia and cover the costs of accommodation, food and domestic travel.

Round-trip flights will be selected from the following routes:

- Beijing–Ulaanbaatar–Beijing
- Seoul–Ulaanbaatar–Seoul
- Tokyo–Ulaanbaatar–Tokyo
- Moscow–Ulaanbaatar–Moscow
- Berlin–Ulaanbaatar–Berlin
- Frankfurt–Ulaanbaatar–Frankfurt
- San Francisco–Ulaanbaatar–San Francisco
- Chicago–Ulaanbaatar–Chicago

SELECTION PROCEDURES WILL BE
ORGANIZED BY THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

To qualify, applicants must:

1. Be a foreign citizen /citizens of Mongolia are ineligible/;
2. Be an undergraduate student who studies Mongolian language or Mongolian studies;
3. Be available for a 10–15 minute interview in Mongolian /either in person or video/ with Selection committee of the Embassy of Mongolia in Washington DC on the topic of Mongolia and Mongolian people;

The interview schedules will be given by the Embassy of Mongolia.

A maximum of 50 points will be awarded for each interview in terms of 10 points each for pronunciation, vocabulary, content, sentence structure and verbal skill.

4. Qualified candidates must write an essay of 250 to 300 words in Mongolian at the Embassy of Mongolia in Washington DC /Essay topic will be given to each applicant at the beginning of the writing. The essay of the candidate shall be sealed and delivered to the Central Selection Committee in Ulaanbaatar. The essay will be examined by the Selection Commission./

The essay will be taken on Wednesday, May 10, 2017 at the Embassy of Mongolia in Washington DC.

A maximum of 50 points will be awarded for each essay in terms of 10 points each for vocabulary, correct sentence structure, content, sentence style and orthography.

The Central Selection Committee shall finalize the scores of the essay and interview and the scholarship recipient will be announced. The Central Selection Committee shall provide the scholarship recipient's name to the Embassy of Mongolia Washington DC by 01 June 2017. The Admission Committee shall award the certificate to each of the scholarship recipients and is responsible for issuing a visa for Mongolia.
